Respect Life Sunday: This weekend, in the Archdiocese of Sydney we are celebrating Respect Life Sunday. This year we are focusing upon the Christian experience of bereavement and grief, following the death of a loved one. A brochure on this theme, *Life is Changed, Not Ended: Bereavement and Grief in the Catholic Tradition* has been distributed to Sydney parishes. Please take one home to read and to pass on to others. Prayer for the Synod on the Family (4th-25th Oct): Jesus, Mary and Joseph, in you we contemplate the splendour of true love, to you we turn with trust. Holy Family of Nazareth, grant that our families too may be places of communion and prayer, authentic schools of the Gospel and small domestic churches. Holy Family of Nazareth, may families never again experience violence, rejection and division: may all who have been hurt or scandalised find ready comfort and healing. Holy Family of Nazareth, may the Synod of Bishops make us once more mindful of the sacredness of the family, and its beauty in God's plan. Jesus, Mary and Joseph, graciously hear our prayer. Amen. Glory be...

XIV Ordinary Synod of Bishops (in Rome from 4th - 25th Oct): Theme: The Vocation and Mission of the Family in the Church and the Contemporary World. The Synod of Bishops is the coming together (usually every 3 years) of the Pope with Bishops from around the world to discuss important issues facing the Church. So why all the attention on this Synod? It has attracted far more attention than any other Synod in living memory, probably because... 1) the topic, that is the family, is where we live our most intimate relationships; 2) there are massive sociological changes that families face; 3) there is wide interest in Pope Francis. The Pope sees sharing 'the joy of the Gospel' as both affirming the goodness of faith-filled families and welcoming in a non-judgemental manner those who live outside these families. This is a huge challenge that families face daily. It may require a shift in church attitudes at many levels. In fact the Pope considers this so important that he has convened two synods on the topic, each with worldwide consultations. The first, held last year, will be used as the starting point for the coming XIV Ordinary Synod in October. So this is really a two-year listening process and we are called to pray for the guidance of the Holy Spirit through this careful process. Let's pray specially for our two attending Australian Bishops, Archbishop Mark Coleridge of Brisbane and Bishop Eugene Hurley of Darwin. Finally, the Pope is expected to publish his conclusions. 'The family which experiences the joy of faith communicates it naturally. That family is the salt of the earth and the light of the world; it is the leaven of society' - Pope Francis.

Tips from Pope Francis: **Parents**, don't forget to kiss! Love is contagious. Kissing the front of children is "a beautiful witness", he said. "When they see that Dad and Mum love each other, the children grow in that climate of love, happiness and security." **Children**, talk to your best friend. Be apostles of peace at home & school, the Pope told children. "Talk to your best friend, Jesus", he said. "Remind your parents, brothers and sisters and friends that misunderstandings can be overcome - when we are united with Jesus everything is possible". **Grandparents**, know how much you are needed. Kids need the most important gifts that grandparents can give: encouragement, wisdom, hope and faith and especially their prayers. **The engaged:** Engagement needs to be a time of getting to know one another and sharing a plan. Learn from Christian spouses, rediscover the Bible, prayer and the Sacraments. Prepare to truly receive one another "with the grace of Christ" and fraternity with the poor. And...enjoy the journey!
