### **St Andrew**

Andrew was a fisherman before he and his brother Simon Peter became two of the 12 disciples of Jesus. He was baptised by John the Baptist and was the first disciple of Jesus. Because he followed Jesus before St. Peter and the others, he is called the *Protoklete* or “First Called” apostle.

St Andrew was crucified on 30 November 60AD, by order of the Roman governor Aegeas. He was tied to an X-shaped cross in Greece, and this is represented by the white cross on the Scottish flag, the Saltire, since at least 1385. Considered Jesus' first disciple, Andrew did not become the official patron saint of Scotland until about 1,300 years after his death - and never actually set foot in the country during his lifetime. Scotland celebrates St Andrew's Day on Monday, with a bank holiday and festivities across the country.
