COVID-19 Safety Plan

Our Covid-19 Safety Plan (copy available in Church) states :

1. All must be aware of content of Safety Plan.

Following on from Archbishop Fisher's consecration of the Archdiocese to Our Lady, Help of Christians in May, we are using October – the month of the Most Holy Rosary – to encourage families to pray the Rosary together with renewed fervour. To this end, the Pilgrim Statue of Our Lady, Help of Christians will visit 31 parishes throughout the month.

Saint Teresa of Ávila

Saint Teresa of Ávila (1515–1582) also known as St Teresa of Jesus, was a Spanish noblewoman, writer and reformer of the Carmelite order. As a young child, Teresa would often retreat into silence for prayer and would enjoy giving alms to the poor.

One of the most famous miracles attributed to her is similar to the miracle of Jesus and Lazarus. The wall of a building fell on Teresa's young nephew and he was crushed. Apparently dead, he was brought to Teresa. She held her little nephew in her arm and prayed deeply. Minutes later, the boy came back to life. This miracle, was presented at Teresa's canonization. Her feast day is 15th October.

Saint Luke

Luke, the author of the third gospel account (and the Acts of the Apostles), is symbolized by a winged ox or bull – a figure of sacrifice, service and strength. ... The ox signifies that Christians should be prepared to sacrifice themselves to follow Christ. The "Hail Mary" prayer is recorded in the Gospel of Luke. The prayer incorporates two greetings to Mary : "Hail, full of grace, the Lord is with thee." and "Blessed art thou amongst women and blessed is the fruit of thy womb.". Luke is the longest of the four gospels and the longest book in the New Testament; together with Acts of the Apostles it makes up a two-volume work from the same author, called Luke–Acts.
