COVID-19 Safety Plan

Our Covid-19 Safety Plan (copy available in Church) states :

1. All must be aware of content of Safety Plan.

November Memorial Masses:

Envelopes are now available for your Mass intentions. Please place these envelopes in the special box at the altar. Individual Mass intentions will be published in the bulletin. All November Masses will also be offered for the souls of our dearly departed friends and relatives.

The traditional conditions to attain a Plenary indulgence

A plenary indulgence can be gained only one per day. The faithful must be in the state of grace and these three conditions must accompany the prescribed act.

1. The faithful must receive the sacrament of confession , either eight days before or after the pious act is performed,
2. Receive Holy Communion on that day.
3. and recite prayers for the intentions of the Holy Father (one Our Father and one Hail Mary is the minimum, but any other additional prayers may be added).

Indulged Acts for the Poor Souls:

One can gain a plenary indulgence by visiting a cemetery each day between November 1 to November 8. These indulgences are only applicable to the Souls in Purgatory.

A plenary indulgence, again only applicable to the Souls in Purgatory, is also granted when the faithful piously visit a church or a public oratory on November 2. In visiting the church or oratory, it is required that one our Father and the Creed be recited.

A partial indulgence (the person does not meet the requirements above or still influenced by venial sin) can be obtained by devoutly visiting a cemetery and praying for the departed, even if the prayer is only mental during the year but especially during the month of November.

Simon and Jude.

Simon and Jude travelled together to teach others about Jesus. Because of their eyewitness accounts of Jesus' miracles and his death and Resurrection, many people became believers and were baptized. . Simon was often called "the Zealot." A zealot is a person who is strongly committed to something. Simon had a nickname to keep people from confusing him with the other apostle named Simon, the one Jesus called Peter. Simon and Jude died for their faith on the same day in Beirut. Jude's body was later returned to Rome where it was buried in a crypt under St. Peter's Basilica. Jude was also known as "Jude Thaddeus". Jude is the patron saint of hopeless cases and desperate situations. People often pray to Jude when they feel that there is no one else to turn to. They ask Jude to bring their problem to Jesus. Because Jude had such great faith, we know that nothing is impossible for those who believe in the Lord.
