St Mary Magdalene

Mary Magdalene is a woman in all four gospels of the New Testament. She became a faithful follower of Jesus after he delivered her from seven demons. She witnessed the crucifixion and burial of Jesus, and was the first person to see and talk with him after he rose from the dead. She was the first to preach the “Good News” of that miracle. She told the apostles that she had seen him alive. Mary Magdalene’s birthplace was Magdala- a booming fish town on the shores of the sea of Galilee (Jesus preached and performed many miracles at the Sea of Galilee per the Bible, New Testament). Her name Magdalene came from her birth town, meaning tower.

She is known as the “Apostle to the Apostles.” She is remembered on 22nd July.
